



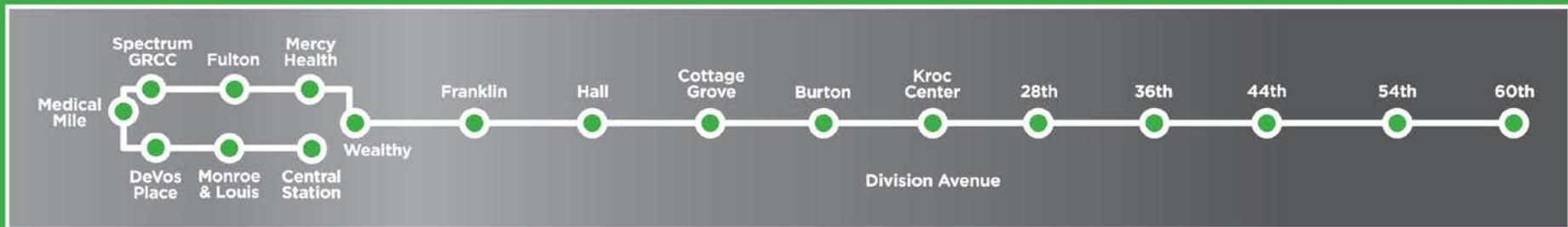

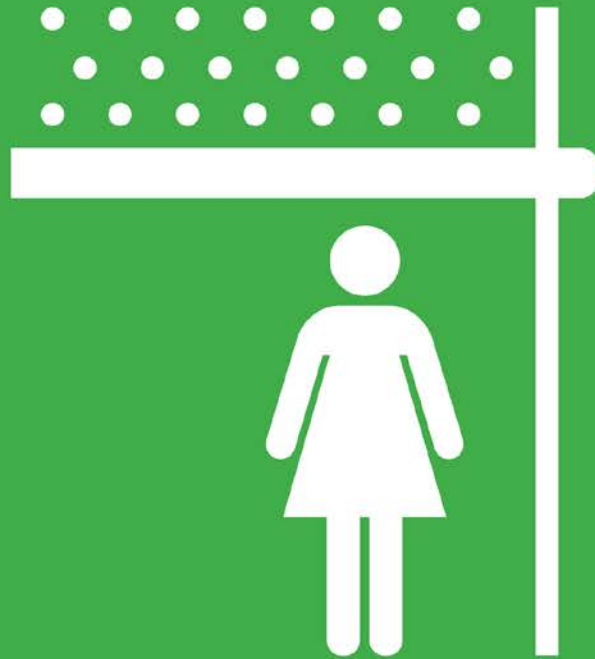
Experience an innovative, new way of getting around.

BLURRING THE LINE BETWEEN BUS AND TRAIN

The Silver Line is like a light rail system on wheels, transporting commuters north and south on Division from 60th to Michigan, looping through the busiest part of Downtown Grand Rapids.



WE'VE GOT YOU COVERED

Silver Line stations offer shelter, next-bus signage, a sidewalk snowmelt system, camera surveillance, and emergency phones.



RAISING EXPECTATIONS

The raised platforms at each Silver Line station make boarding easy and accessible for everyone.



MAKING THINGS FARE

Each station is equipped with a ticket vending machine. Riders pay and validate their fare ahead of time, which saves time and allows for faster boarding.

Now staying connected is even easier with free Wi-Fi on all Silver Line buses. So grab your smart phone, tablet, or laptop to work, chat, or surf the web while we do the driving.
